The editor and members of the editorial board invite submissions from across all geographic specializations (human, physical, and GIScience) and allied disciplines including but not limited to planning, geology, environmental science, sociology, urban studies, economics, and public policy. *Applied Geography* is a journal devoted to the publication of research which uses geographical theory and methodology to resolve those human problems that have a geographical dimension. These problems may be related to the assessment, management and allocation of the world's physical and/or human resources. The underlying rationale of the journal is that only through a clear understanding of the relevant societal and physical systems can we resolve such problems.

Papers are invited on any theme involving the application of geographical theory and methodology in the resolution of human problems. This may include papers on the techniques, problems and results of environmental and/or social research, as well as those concerned with the principles, policies and consequences of resource management and allocation.
